Our Objectives



Equine Assisted Activities

Equine Assisted Activities (EAA) have been utilized in the United States since the 1950's and have been identified as beneficial forms of exercise and recreation for people with a wide range of disabilities. EAA combines goals in sports, recreation, therapy and education.

Therapeutic Riding

Includes basic instruction in grooming, tacking, horsemanship, riding and/or driving skills. Classes include mounted exercise, games, trail riding, and much more.

Equine Animal Activities

Students work with instructors on basic instruction in grooming and horsemanship. Students do not mount a horse or cart in participation, but are provided with general learning about horses and their care, and also get to spend time bonding with the horses.

Lessons

Classes begin in April and run through October. Both day and evening hours are available. All classes are taught by PATH certified instructors.

Summer Session - June—July
Fall Session - September-October
